



Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Update Announcement

Moretown is looking for the public's assistance in identifying local hazards as we update the Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP).

The federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, requires all municipalities to complete a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan every five years in order to qualify for FEMA funding when a disaster occurs. The plan aids in identifying threats and hazards such as flooding, winter storms, and power failures. It determines mitigation efforts to reduce risk and assist in recovering from natural, technological, and human-caused hazards.

Moretown has begun the plan update process and is looking for input from Moretown residents to help identify hazards that impact the community.
